Western Region committee members visited Asha Sadan, Umerkhadi, Mumbai on 20th August, 2017. Asha Sadan is a children's home for care and protection of underprivileged children and the major project of Maharashtra State Women's Council. Asha Sadan has daycare for new born children upto the age of six. The residential school of Asha Sadan has 150 girls of different age groups.
